



# Group Short Term Disability Insurance

Group Short Term Disability insurance from Standard Insurance Company helps provide financial protection for insured members by promising to pay a weekly benefit in the event of a covered disability.

The cost of this insurance is contributory or non-contributory, as determined by the employer.

## Eligibility

<b>Definition of a Member</b>	A regular employee of a Participating Employer of the Printers' Disability Trust, actively working at least 30 hours per week, and a citizen or resident of the United States or Canada. An eligible employees does not include a temporary or seasonal employee, a full-time member of the armed forces, a leased employee or an independent contractor.
<b>Eligibility Waiting Period</b>	The eligibilty waiting period will be determined by the employer.

## Benefits

<b>Weekly Benefit</b>	60 percent of the weekly predisability earnings as of the date of disability, reduced by deductible income (e.g., work earnings, workers' compensation, state disability, etc.)
<b>Maximum Weekly Benefit</b>	\$300, \$600, \$900 or \$1,200
<b>Minimum Weekly Benefit</b>	\$15
<b>Benefit Waiting Period</b>	The weekly benefit becomes payable the first day the employee is disabled for disability caused by accidental injury and after 7 days for disability caused by physical disease, pregnancy or mental disorder.

<b>Definition of Disability</b>	<p>For the benefit waiting period and while the Short Term Disability benefits are payable, the employee is considered disabled if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Unable – as a result of physical disease, injury, pregnancy or mental disorder – to perform with reasonable continuity the material duties of the employee's own occupation, and</li><li>• Suffer a loss of at least 20 percent of predisability earnings when working in the employee's own occupation</li></ul> <p>Employees are not considered disabled merely because their right to perform their own occupation is restricted, including a restriction or loss of license.</p> <p>Employees will no longer be considered disabled when earnings from any occupation meet or exceed 80 percent of predisability earnings.</p>
<b>Maximum Benefit Period</b>	<p>Plan A - 13 weeks</p> <p>Plan B - 26 weeks</p>

A group certificate of insurance that describes the terms and conditions of the group policy is available for those who become insured according to its terms.

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
