



## GROUP BASIC LIFE INSURANCE

Basic Life insurance from Standard Insurance Company helps provide financial protection by promising to pay a benefit in the event of an eligible employee's covered death.

The cost of your insurance is paid for by your PEBB Participating Organization.

Eligibility	
<b>Definition of a Member</b>	You are a member if you are an active employee of a PEBB Participating Organization as defined in Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) 101-010-0005, who is regularly scheduled to work and who meets the terms of eligibility outlined in the PEBB Administrative Rules.
<b>Class Definition</b>	<b>Class 1</b> All active employees of the Judicial Management Service <b>Class 2</b> All other active eligible employees
<b>Eligibility Waiting Period</b>	You are eligible on the date you become an eligible employee. However, if you are an elected and appointed official you are eligible on the first day of the month following the month in which you take the oath of office.

Benefits	
<b>Basic Life Coverage Amount</b>	<b>Class 1</b> The Basic Life coverage amount is equal to 1 times your annual earnings, rounded to the next higher multiple of \$1,000, if not already a multiple of \$1,000 <b>Class 2</b> The Basic Life coverage amount is \$10,000
