If you become disabled and can't work, you might need the extra income replacement SLTD insurance provides to pay your bills.

Take the next step during open enrollment

Open enrollment is October 1-31, 2024. During this period, you can elect SLTD coverage or reduce your benefit waiting period from 180 days to 90 days without medical evidence.

It's easy to enroll in SLTD coverage during open enrollment. Log in to MyBenefits at mybenefits.sc.gov to make your coverage selections during open enrollment. Review the *Supplemental Long Term Disability Insurance* booklet at standard.com/mybenefits/scpeba for costs and complete details of coverage.
